

## **IMPLANTS**

Implants are small plastic rods or capsules, each about the size of a matchstick, that release a progestin like the natural hormone progesterone in a woman's body. They are placed just under the skin on the inside of a woman's upper arm by a doctor.

### **How Effective is the Implant?**

The Implant is 99 percent effective. This means that 99 of every 100 women using the Implant will not become pregnant.

### **Who can use Implants?**
